CSGS will fund at least three Free-Standing Course in the College on topics related to gender and/or sexuality. Past courses have included: "Religion, Gender, and Agency"; "Girlhood in American Literature"; "Masculinity in America, Past and Present"; and "Sex and the State." The grad teaching selection committee is looking for courses that will be of general interest to College students interested in issues or theories of gender and sexuality.

## **Qualifications:**

We invite applications for these positions from all interested Ph.D. students in all divisions and professional schools. Students applying to teach must have passed their preliminary examinations by October 1, 2015.

Applications should consist of the following:

- The application form (attached)
- Current CV
- Course description and reading list or syllabus
- One letter of recommendation from a member of the faculty

Fellows will receive \$5,000 for the individual undergraduate course they will teach in the College.

Application materials should be submitted in PDF form by email to csgsteachingapplications@lists.uchicago.edu. This is a secure, dedicated site for CSGS applications.
